

Section 1310 - Municipal Parking Facilities.

1310.01. Publicly owned parking lots. The city may establish, improve and maintain public parking lots, ramps or other facilities for motor vehicles on any real property owned by or leased to the city within or outside the city limits, and which is used for any public use, convenience or purpose, and may adopt rules and regulations governing such parking facilities and may determine and establish charges to be paid by persons who park motor vehicles on such public parking lots, and may limit the use of such parking lots to residents of the city and other municipalities designated by the council.

1310.03. General rule. It is unlawful to park a motor vehicle on a public parking lot in violation of regulations of the commission relating thereto, or without paying the charge for such parking established by the council.

1310.05. Time zones in public parking lots. The manager with the approval of the council may from time to time establish parking time zones upon any publicly owned or operated parking lot or upon any portion or portions thereof; and shall thereupon mark or cause to be marked by appropriate signs any such zone or zones so established. No person shall park any vehicle upon any part of any such parking lot beyond the time established therein or thereon.

1310.07. Limited parking lot permits. Subdivision 1. Definitions. For the purpose of subsection 1315.07 to 1315.15, the terms defined in this subsection have the meanings given them.

Subd. 2. "Motor vehicles" mean passenger automobiles and trucks having a capacity of not more than one ton.

Subd. 3. "Limited parking lots" means those municipally owned or controlled parking lots designated by the council for parking of motor vehicles by only those persons possessing valid limited lot permits as set forth in this section.

Subd. 4. "Public parking lots" means those municipally owned or controlled parking lots of the city other than limited parking lots.

1310.09. Limited lot permits. There are established and continued limited lot permits which may be issued monthly, quarterly, or yearly upon a suitable card or other document by the clerk to applicant, upon payment of the fee. Each such limited lot permit shall contain the license number of the motor vehicle, the name and address of the person to whom issued, and the period of time for which such permit is issued. Such limited lot permit shall be attached to and prominently displayed upon the described motor vehicle. Such permit shall be valid only for the vehicle described thereon for the month, quarter, or year of its issue and shall entitle the vehicle described thereon to remain parked in any limited parking lot for the time period established by the City Council. 1310.11. Special parking permits. There are established and continued special parking permits which may be issued upon a suitable card or other document by the clerk to any applicant, upon payment of the required fee. These permits are available to any individual, in whatever quantity necessary, to allow for parking beyond the established parking time limit. An expiration date of the last day of the year when the permit is issued shall be printed on each Special Use Permit. Nonprofit organizations may make application for reduced fee Special Use Permits. (Amended Ord. No. 91-698, Section 2)

1310.13. Fees. Permit fees shall be established and set forth by City Council resolution. (Amended Ord. No. 91-698, Section 3)

1310.15. Forgery. No permit issued under this section shall be changed, mutilated, altered, substituted or forged.
