

Section 345 - Absentee Ballot Board

345.01 Establishment. There is created and continued an Absentee Ballot Board pursuant to Chapter 203B of the Minnesota Election Laws.

345.03 Appointment. An Absentee Ballot Board shall be a board of two or more election judges appointed by the City Council as provided in Sections 204B.19 to 204B.22 of the Minnesota Election Laws.

345.05 Duties. The Absentee Ballot Board shall meet and take receipt of all return absentee ballot envelopes from the City Clerk at City Hall. The election judges shall examine and process said absentee ballots pursuant to Minn. Stats. Section 203B.001 et seq.
