Renew Your Rental License



Rental licenses are required to be renewed on an annual basis by October 31 of each year.

Any changes in Owner or Manager contact information requires an amended license to be completed and submitted to the City. Find license applications to update, apply or renew online at

Heat required!



Heat is required to be provided from October 1 - May 15 per City of Hopkins Property Maintenance Code 405 IPMC 602.3 Heat supply. The temperature shall be not less than 68 degrees Fahrenheit; measured 3 feet from the floor near the center of the room and 2 feet from the outside wall (City Code 405 IPMC 602.5).

HVAC Inspections

The City of Hopkins requires all heating and cooling systems in rental properties to be inspected by a licensed heating contractor a minimum of every two years using the HVAC form. This applies to furnaces and central air units older than 5 years old. Forms can be found online.

Fire Doors

Keep your building fire safe! Fire doors must stay closed unless they are interconnected to the fire alarm system. Fire doors are a fire rated assembly and are factory tested. Fire doors are office doors, apartment doors, doors for the corridor; i.e. shop doors, boiler room doors, etc. City Property Maintenance Code 405 IPMC 703.1 Opening **Protectives**

Dogs

All dogs must be licensed with the City of Hopkins per Hopkins City Code Section 925. Dog License applications and more animal information can be found on our website.

Not more than 2 dogs and 2 cats are allowed per household or 4 cats and no dogs.
