REGISTER TO VOTE NOW Go to mnvotes.org to register to vote. It's quick and easy! You will need your Minnesota driver's license or Minnesota Identification card number, or the last four numbers of your Social Security number. Register to vote prior to October 18 to ensure you are registered on Election Day. If you plan to register to vote at the polls, refer to the handout and bring proper identification. Registration forms are also available at City Hall.

FIND YOUR POLLING PLACE The polls will be open on Tuesday, November 8 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Use the Secretary of State's Polling Place Finder at mnvotes.org to make sure you are going to the correct polling place on Election Day. Simply enter your address to find your polling place (where you vote, map and directions) along with a sample ballot for your precinct.

VOTE EARLY BY ABSENTEE BALLOT You do not have to wait until Election Day to vote. You can vote early by absentee ballot. Eligible voters may vote in person at City Hall or by mail. To vote early by mail, request an absentee ballot at mnvotes.org. Absentee ballots will be available at City Hall starting Friday, September 23 through Monday, November 7 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

EXTENDED HOURS FOR ABSENTEE VOTING The new "direct balloting" method starts November 1. Direct balloting allows you to deposit your ballot directly into the ballot counter at City Hall. To accommodate our residents City Hall will be open until 6 p.m. November 1 through 4; Saturday, November 5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.; and on Monday, November 7 until 5 p.m.
