

Subd. 2 Firefighter

Position Summary: This represents the base level position of the department. All firefighters are certified to this level prior to being accepted for regular membership. The Firefighter is responsible for carrying out tasks as directed by an officer in order to assure efficient day to day operations of the department. The Firefighter is responsible for all property issued to him/her and any equipment utilized in the performance of his/her duties. The Firefighter will do his/her part in the establishment and maintenance of good public relations. The Firefighter may serve as a vital part of specific committees or programs such as public education. The Firefighter is responsible for conducting his/her activities in a safe and professional manner.

Position Requirements

The Firefighter shall have completed the department's probationary firefighter period.

The firefighter shall have met all requirements for Firefighter I and II as defined in the department's training standards.

The Firefighter shall have completed all mandatory schooling and testing as defined by the department's training standards.

The Firefighter shall have performed satisfactorily during his/her probationary firefighter period as determined by company officers.

The Firefighter shall meet the requirements of the SOG's of the department to be a regular member.

The Firefighter shall complete the CPAT test annually as terms of employment

Position Relationships - The Firefighter receives supervision and direction from a company officer. On an emergency scene the Firefighter receives direction from the officer on the apparatus on which he/she is responding.

Position Responsibilities:

Actively participate in fire prevention and public fire education. Meeting or exceeding the department's training standards each year.

Working to constantly improve his/her skills and knowledge
Maintaining all property and equipment issued to him/her.

Addressing problems at the earliest stage through the chain of command

Performing tasks assigned by an officer at an emergency scene.

Participating in company and department work details

Aiding in the orientation and guidance of probationary firefighters

Learning and adhering to the department's constitution, SOG's, policies, and standard operating guidelines

Performing CPAT Test Annually
