


Downtown Park

Shelter capacity:	75
Parking:	64 vehicles in parking lot & additional ramp parking
Electrical Service:	Available on stage and drop box
Water Service:	Drinking Fountain – no spigot
Restroom Facilities:	1 standard and 1 ADA portable restroom – May – Oct
Park Amenities:	Drinking fountain; performance stage; plaza; dedication benches

HOW TO RESERVE THE DOWNTOWN PARK

To get an application for the Downtown Park, visit www.hopkinsmn.com/parks or stop by the Hopkins Pavilion at 11000 Excelsior Blvd or call 952-939-1410. A reservation permit is required for groups of 25 or more wishing to use the Downtown Park. Upon receipt of your application, the Scheduling Coordinator will review your information, check for conflicts, and if approved, will send you a confirmation of your request. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to reserve the facility.

DATES OF AVAILABILITY

The park is available May through October. Rentals outside of these dates are welcome but application approval will be based on the parks condition and maintenance needs.

RESERVATION HOURS

The park may be reserved between the hours of 10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

BEER & WINE PERMITS

Beer and wine is permitted by special permit only.

RESERVATION PRIORITY POLICY

Applications for Hopkins Community Organizations will be accepted year-round, but must be received by March 1st to be given priority for the current year. All other groups and individuals may submit request dates beginning March 1.

PARK RULES

Applicants are responsible for following the park rules as established by the City of Hopkins. The following is a summary of activities that are prohibited in the City of Hopkins Parks. For detailed provisions refer to Section 830, Hopkins City Code.

PROHIBITED

- Motor vehicles, snowmobiles, and golf
- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages
- Glass bottles of any kind
- Overnight parking
- Use of tobacco products

DOGS IN PARKS

Leashed dogs are allowed on trails and open areas only. Dog owners must clean up after their dog. Dogs not allowed in picnic or play areas or athletic fields. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
